Think Energy president to speak on energy issues

Think Energy Management LLC announced that its president **Richard G. Lubinski** has asked to speak on energy management at two conferences this fall:

On Sept. 15, Lubinski will chair a panel discussion at the 2006 World Energy Engineering Congress in Washington DC. The topic will be "Energy Policy."

The panel will discuss the changes in the energy industry and how Federal energy policy affects energy efficiency projects, energy costs and other trends.

He will be joined by Peter Funk, partner with Duane Morris LLC talking about the "Energy Policy Act of 2005." Richard Itteilag will address the "Energy Policy Impact on Energy Services Companies" and Frank Yeboah, Ph.D. will address "Future Zero Emission Carbon Technology — Valuation and Policy Issues."

The 2006 WEEC is expected to draw 7,000 people.

On Sept. 20, Lubinski will

present "How to sell your energy management project to a CFO" at Facilities Midwest Conference and Expo in Chicago. The conference is expected to draw 2,500 people.

The US EPA/US DOE sponsored EnergyStar program has requested he give this same energy management talk at its regional EnergyStar partner meetings.

Lubinski is a Life Member of the Association of Energy Engineers and serves as the president of the Northern Ohio chapter of AEE. He holds several national professional certifications including: Certified Energy Manager, Certified Demand side Management Professional, Certified Energy Management Systems Contractor, Certified Business Energy Professional and Certified U.S. Green Lights Survey Ally.
